## **Fractions in words**



You might see fractions in shops, on bills, in newspapers and recipes. It's a good idea to recognise fractions when they are written as words.

fraction	word	plural
<u>1</u> 2	One half (A half)	halves
1 3	One third	thirds
$\frac{1}{4}$	One quarter	quarters
<u>1</u> 5	One fifth	fifths
1 6	One sixth	sixths
<u>1</u> 7	One seventh	sevenths
<u>1</u> 8	One eighth	eighths
<u>1</u> 9	One ninth	ninths
<u>1</u> 10	One tenth	tenths

It's easy really to make the words, apart from the first four.All the other fractions are like the numbers but with a 'th' sound added at the end.

Even easier is making the plurals, as long as you are careful with the plural of  $\frac{1}{2}$ .

Just put an 's' on the end of the other fractions.
